Voter Registration

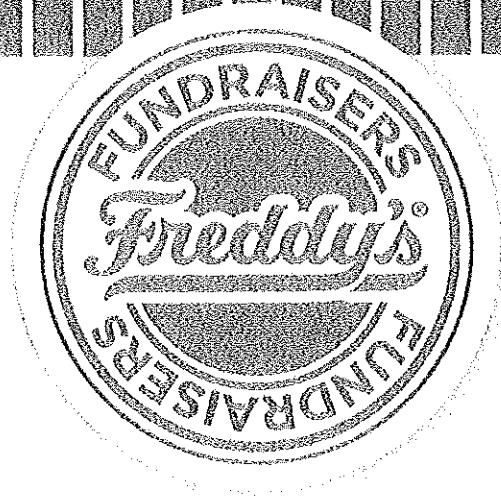

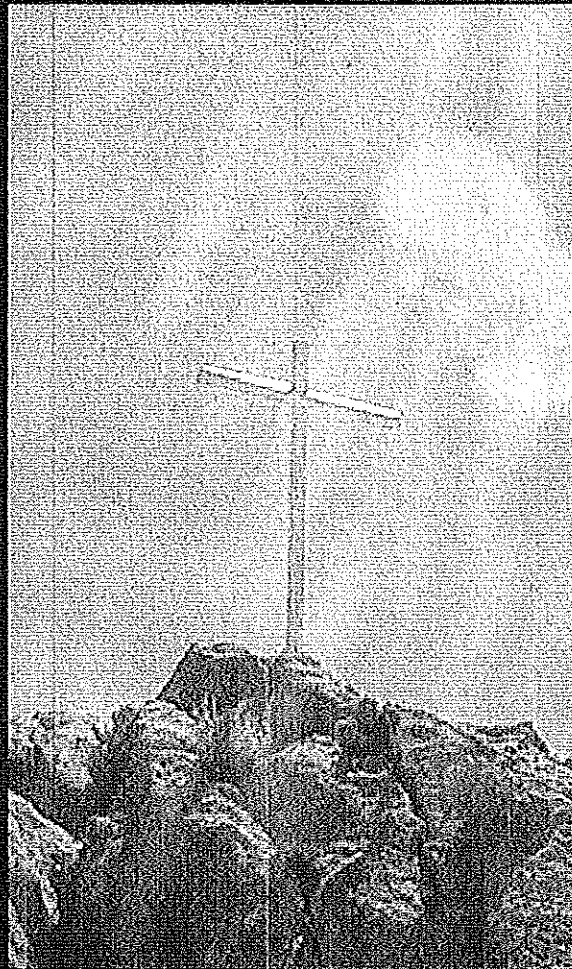

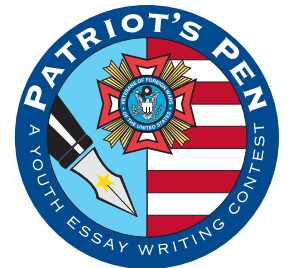
